

RECOGNITION AWARDS:

Department and Nationals Certificates of Recognition: These certificates are to recognize VFW and Auxiliary members deserving of Department of Hawaii recognition because of their achievements. This includes Committee Chairpersons and outstanding volunteers who have achieved or surpassed their goals. Program Committee Chairs, Post Commanders, or Department Leadership may recommend people for this award. Deadline for these awards is March 01, 2026.

To be eligible for any award:

- 1. The award criteria must be met on or before the Department's specified deadline as outlined in this membership plan.
- 2. Membership numbers must be visible on National's website (Memstats) on or before the Department's contest deadline.

Note: To ensure proper credit, please remember to include your name and VFW ID/member number on all Membership Application Forms for every member you recruit.

RECRUITING AWARDS:

Top Recruiter Award: Member who obtained the highest combined overall recruiting numbers for New Reinstated and Life members in the Department will receive a plaque, \$200.00 or other recognition determined by the State Commander and State Membership team. Top Recruiters must recruit a minimum of 40 new or reinstated members of which 10 must be new members.

Fast Start Recruiter Award: Any member recruiting 10 new or reinstated members by December 31, 2025, will receive \$100.00.

Department Recruiting Team Shirt: Any member who recruits 4 new members on Oahu or 3 new members on American Samoa, Kauai, Maui, Molokai, and Hawaii – recruiting 3 new members, by June 1, 2026.

State Convention Meals: A member who recruits 10 new or reinstated members by June 1, 2026, will receive \$75.00 toward the Department Convention meal package. A minimum of 3 new members must be recruited for the \$75.00 award. A member who recruits 20 new or reinstated members by June 1, 2026, will receive \$150.00 toward the Department Convention meal package. A minimum of 6 new members must be recruited for the \$150.00 award. Any member who recruits 30 or more new or reinstated members by June 1, 2026, will receive the Department Convention meal package at no cost. For a no cost meal package a minimum of 10 new members must be recruited. **NO Cash Alternative will be awarded.**

National Convention Recruiting Award: One (1) Round Trip Air Ticket, Hotel room and \$500 for expenses for travel to the VFW National Convention in Reno, Nevada on July 24-30 2026 will be awarded. To win, for each New/Reinstated Member you recruit your name will be entered in the drawing. Deadline for this award June 14, 2026, with the drawing held at the State Convention, the Aloha Banquet Night on Saturday night. Award may be transferred to a deserving Post member. **NO Cash Alternative will be awarded.**

MEMBERSHIP/RECRUITING/DONATIONS GUIDANCE:

This membership program has been designed to recognize and award you for promoting membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars. When recruiting at any Department organized event or location; all donations will be forwarded to the Department QM. Donations will be used for the Department Outreach Programs and/or as the Department Commander directs. When a Post is recruiting alone all donations received will be kept in the Post and Post QM will report the amount

to the post membership. If **Buddy Poppies** are given out and donations are received, donations must be deposited in the **Post Relief Fund** and only used for only the purposes designated in the National Bylaws.

- 1. Membership goal of 101%+ is the National VFW goal for the Post.
- 2. Add 2+ life members.
- 3. Increase Legacy Life membership either by upgraded to a higher level or as a new legacy life member.
- 4. Recruit 5 new members.

The goal is for these events to be in addition to your regular plans, as well as something that fellow veterans can be invited to take part. "Buddy" Poppy, recruiting and events which only raise monetary donations do not qualify as a Day of Service event.	·

ALL STATE: The Top Commanders and Quartermasters will receive a cap, pin, or an appropriate award. Posts not in contention for All State Awards will be considered for other Departmental Awards, based on each Post total score which is evaluated by the Department Leadership. Posts must be over 100% +1 in membership, be in good standing, and submit entries to Department for Voice of Democracy, and Patriots Pen programs. Posts are also evaluated on the whole Post concept for the membership year 2025-2026. May 13, 2026, is the cutoff date for All-State Award consideration. Any Post In arrears is not eligible for All-State recognition. The Post must be in good standing which includes as a minimum current with trustee reports, officers bonded, Post bylaws and Articles of Incorporation (submitted to National), State and National Delegate Fees Paid, all Line Officers Proof of Eligibility submitted to Department, required insurance, Post Inspection completed, IRS 990 filed, and DCCA current.

VFW NATIONAL ALL- AMERICAN PROGRAM REQUIREMENT RECAP: The All-American Program is designed to encourage excellence above and beyond the standard for membership. It is not meant to be awarded to Posts, Districts, or Departments that achieve the bare minimum – it is there to designate the elite, the best of the best. For additional information refer to the All-American Program booklet on the website.

All-American Post Criteria

All Posts who have met the following criteria as of June 30th, 2026 will be named as All-American Posts:

- At least 101% in membership, based on adjusted prior year totals.
- Must have a Post election report submitted and be in good standing.
- Must meet the following Program Participation Criteria by January 31, 2026:
 - Voice of Democracy minimum of one entry advanced to Department judging (Overseas Posts may donate \$125 to National in lieu of entry)
 - Patriot's Pen minimum of one entry advanced to Department judging (Overseas Posts may donate \$125 to National in lieu of entry)



- o Donate to Veterans & Military Support Programs Services, minimum of \$125.
- A Post must submit a community service report quarterly to their department for submission to the All-American Dashboard. The quarters are July-Sept, Oct-Dec, Jan-March, and April-June. One of these community service activities must be for a VFW Day of Service event held during the month of May and registered at todaysvfw.org/day-of-service/ no later than June 1. Learn more about Day of Service at todaysvfw.org/.
- Must purchase a minimum of 500 Buddy Poppies.

All Posts that meet these requirements will be designated as All-American Posts and will receive an All-American Post Streamer, a Post Home Citation, and will be recognized in the VFW Magazine.

All-American Post Award

The top FIFTEEN (15) Posts in each membership division will be allowed to walk across the stage at the National Convention and will receive in addition to the above: All-American Post Citation, All-American Commander's Citation, All-American Name Badge (commander), All-American Cap (commander), All-American lapel pin (commander).

Commanders of Posts that do not finish in the top 15, as well as Quartermasters, Adjutants, and Post Members of an All-American Post will be allowed to purchase All-American caps from the VFW Store.

The top five Post Commanders in each membership division will also receive five nights hotel stay at the National Convention.

Additional Notes:

- No more than one stipend may be given to an individual for a specific event.
- VMS donations must be made through the dashboard; all other donations must be made through the Department Quartermaster.
